

ORDINANCE NO. 3

An Ordinance relating to Public Parks; Prohibiting the possession of alcoholic beverages in Hernando County Park and Recreation Center in Brooksville, Kennedy Park and Roger's Park, all in Hernando County; Providing that a violation of this Ordinance shall be a misdemeanor; And providing for punishment for such violation; Providing an effective date.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Hernando County, Florida:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to have in his or her possession any alcoholic beverages while such person is in that public park known as Hernando County Park and Recreation Center located in the northeast corner of the intersection of Howell Avenue and Ft. Dade Street, Brooksville, Florida, or in that public park known as Kennedy Park located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, Township 22, Range 19, or in that public park known as Roger's Park located on State Road 595 and the Weekiwachee River being South of the said River and east of said road, all in Hernando County, Florida.

Section 2. Any person convicted of a violation of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished as provided by General Law for misdemeanors in 775.07 Florida Statutes.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt by the Board of County Commissioners of notice from the Secretary of State that the same has been filed by the Secretary of State.
