

ORDINANCE NO. 4

An Ordinance relating to and prohibiting dumping or permitting the dumping or disposing of trash upon public roads, streets and highways, waters and waterways, and upon any public property in Hernando County, Florida; Providing that a violation of this Act is a misdemeanor; Setting a penalty therefor; And providing an effective date.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Hernando County, Florida:

Section 1. It is unlawful for any person to dump or cause to be dumped, or place or cause to be placed, any trash, garbage or refuse of any kind whatsoever, into or along the bank of any navigable body of water in Hernando County, Florida, or within fifteen feet of the high water mark of any such navigable body of water.

Section 2. It is unlawful for any person to dump or cause to be dumped, or place or cause to be placed, any trash, garbage or refuse of any kind whatsoever on the right of way of any public highway or any public property which has not been officially designated as a garbage or refuse disposal area.

Section 3. Any person convicted of a violation of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished as provided by Florida Statutes under Sec.775.07.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon receipt by the Board of County Commissioners of notice from the Secretary of State that the same has been filed in the office of the Secretary of State.
