AN ORDINANCE OF HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING HERNANDO COUNTY ORDINANCE 93-18, BINGO REGULATIONS; PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENT OF SECTION XXII SUCH THAT A LESSOR MAY BE PERMITTED TO ALLOW BINGO TO BE CONDUCTED UP TO THREE (3) TIMES IN ONE (1) WEEK AT A FACILITY RENTED FOR SUCH PURPOSE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That Section XXII, Lessors, of Hernando County Ordinance 93-18 be amended so that such Section shall read as follows:

A. SECTION XXII. LESSORS

"It shall be unlawful for a person to lease, sublease, assign or rent any premises for the conduct of bingo, or agree to the use of any premises for the conduct of Bingo, unless the person shall have a current and valid Class B permit under this Chapter, which permit shall not be under suspension or permanently or conditionally revoked.

The holder of a Class B permit may not lease or otherwise allow its premises to be used for the conduct of Bingo more than three (3) times in one (1) week. The requirement for a Class B permit shall not apply when a permitted organization holding a Class A permit is the owner of the premises upon which it conducts bingo games only and solely for its own benefit."

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY

It is declared to be the intent of the Board of County Commissioners that if any section, subsection, clause, sentence phrase or provision of this Ordinance is for any reason held unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. INCLUSION IN THE CODE

The provisions of this ordinance shall be included and incorporated in the Code of Ordinances of Hernando County as an addition or amendment thereto and shall be appropriately renumbered to conform to the uniform numbering system of the Code.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective upon receipt of official acknowledgement from the Secretary of State that said Ordinance has been filed.
