

ORDINANCE NO. 84-9

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING HERNANDO COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 83-2 PERTAINING TO THE HERNANDO BEACH MUNICIPAL FIRE SERVICE UNIT; PROVIDING FOR AN AMENDMENT TO THE PROVISIONS FOR THE DURATION OF THE UNIT BY REQUIRING ANY TRANSFER AND CONVEYANCE OF THE UNIT'S ASSETS TO BE SUBJECT TO A REVERSIONARY INTEREST IN HERNANDO COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Hernando County Ordinance No. 83-2 creating the Hernando Beach Municipal Fire Service Unit is hereby amended as follows:

"SECTION IX. DURATION OF UNIT


The Hernando Beach Municipal Fire Service Unit shall exist for a two-year period, beginning on April 27, 1983, and ending on April 27, 1985. Upon termination of the Unit, all assets of the District shall be transferred and conveyed to the Hernando Beach Volunteer Fire Department; provided, however, that any such conveyance shall contain a restriction that the assets are to be used solely by the Hernando Beach Volunteer Fire Department and if at any time the assets are sought to be transferred or conveyed, that said assets will revert to Hernando County. The transfer and conveyance of said assets shall further be conditioned upon a provision in such transfer and conveyance that in the event of the cessation of the Hernando Beach Volunteer Fire Department as a viable entity, the assets of said Hernando Beach Municipal Fire Service Unit shall revert to Hernando County."

SECTION 2. A certified copy of this Ordinance shall be filed with the Secretary of State by the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners within ten (10) days after adoption of this Ordinance and shall take effect immediately upon said filing.


