

ORDINANCE NO. 85- 10

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CONSTRUCTION CODE OF HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA, ORDINANCE NO. 85-2 BY: AMENDING SECTION 300, SUBSECTION 301.1(1) TO CHANGE THE COMPOSITION OF THE CONSTRUCTION LICENSING BOARD TO NINE (9) MEMBERS; AMENDING SECTION 300, SUBSECTION 301.2 TO PROVIDE FOR TERMS OF OFFICE FOR THE NINE MEMBER BOARD; AMENDING SECTION 300, SUBSECTION 301.3 TO PROVIDE A QUORUM FOR THE NINE MEMBER BOARD; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERANCE CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Hernando County Ordinance No. 85-2, Section 300, Subsection 301.1(1) is hereby amended to read as follows:

301.1 Composition

1. There is hereby created a Construction Licensing Board (hereafter referred to as the "Board") consisting of nine (9) members from different trades as specified below, to the extent possible. However, each trade needs to be represented by at least one member. The Board members shall hold an active license from Hernando County in their respective trade.

Building	2 Members
Plumbing	2 Members
Electrical	2 Members
Mechanical	2 Members
Laity	1 Member

SECTION 2. Hernando County Ordinance No. 85-2, Section 300, Subsection 301.2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

301.2 Terms of Office

The nine (9) members shall be appointed by the Governing Body as follows: Three (3) shall be appointed for a period of three (3) years; three (3) for a period of two (2) years; and three (3) for a period of one (1) year. Thereafter, all appointments shall be for four (4) year terms and shall continue unless sooner removed for malfeasance in office, neglect of duty, incapacity, or other sufficient causes.

SECTION 3. Hernando County Ordinance No. 85-2, Section 300, Subsection 301.3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

301.3 Quorum

Five (5) members of the Board shall constitute a quorum, in the application of any provision of this ordinance or the official duties of this Board.

Affirmative votes of the majority present shall be required.

SECTION 4. Severance of Parts

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance, for any reason, is held to be unconstitutional, void or invalid, the validity of the remaining portions of said ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective as provided by law, but in no event prior to May 14, 1985.
