

ORDINANCE NO. 85-22

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING HERNANDO
COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 85-21

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE HERNANDO COUNTY BOARD OF
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Hernando County Ordinance No. 85-21 is hereby
rescinded.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall become effective as of
12:00 Noon, Tuesday, October 1, 1985.


SECTION 3. This ordinance is adopted as an emergency
ordinance as a result of the termination of the emergency situation
which previously existed due to the severe flooding of the Withla-
coochee River which had necessitated the prohibition of the use of
boats, other than for law enforcement or other governmental agencies
for evacuation purposes, on the Withlacoochee River.
