BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION I. AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 8.

That Chapter 8 of the Code of Ordinances of Hernando County, Florida be amended as follows:

- A. Section 8-73, change this section as follows:
  - 1. Change the title to read: "Sec. 8-73 Sanctions."
  - 2. Delete first sentence of 8-73(a) and replace with, "(a) grounds for Board action. The Board shall either issue a letter of reprimand to a certificate holder, suspend, place on probation, revoke, or modify the certificate holder's permit privileges, or suspend or revoke a certificate holder's certificate of competency when finding a violation of any of the following subparagraphs. A letter of reprimand will not be used as a penalty for violations of subparagraphs (3) through (7) or (10) through (14).
  - 3. Subparagraph 8-73 (a)(1) through 8-73 (a)(14) remain unchanged.

SECTION II. SEVERABILITY.

It is declared to be the intent of the Board of County Commissioners that if any section, subsection, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this Ordinance is for any reason held unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not

affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION III. INCLUSION IN THE CODE.

It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners of Hernando County, Florida, and it is hereby provided, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of Hernando County, Florida. To this end, the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention, and that the word "ordinance," may be changed to "section," "article," or other appropriate designation.

SECTION IV. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment from the office of the Secretary of State of Florida that this Ordinance has been filed with said office.
