AN ORDINANCE OF HERNANDO COUNTY PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF SECTION 12-92 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA; PERTAINING TO THE CHANGE OF EXHIBIT "A"; PROVIDING PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION I AMENDMENT OF SECTION 12-92. Section 12-92 of the Code of Ordinances of Hernando County, Florida, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 12-92. Creation of Unit.

For the purpose of creating, establishing, maintaining and operating a fire protection system within the area described herein, there is hereby created a municipal service taxing unit to be known as the "Northwest Hernando County Fire Protection Service Unit," which shall be all the property within the boundaries described in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference, located in the county."

SECTION II INCLUSION IN THE CODE. It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners of Hernando County, Florida, and it is hereby provided, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of Hernando County, Florida. To this end, the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention, and that the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section", "article", or other appropriate designation.

SECTION III SEVERABILITY. It is declared to be the intent of the Board of County Commissioners that if any section,

subsection, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this Ordinance is for any reason held unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance, adopted pursuant to the Emergency Enactment Procedure of §125.66 (3), Florida Statutes, shall become effective when a copy has been accepted by the United States Postal Service for special delivery by registered mail to the Department of State.

All of Township 22, Range 17 less that portion of Section 36 contained within the Spring Hill Fire District.

All of Township 22, Range 18, less High Point Mobile Home Subdivision Units 1-6 and less that portion contained within Spring Hill Fire District.

Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 of Township 23, Range 17 less that portion contained within Spring Hill Fire District.

Sections 1, 2, 3, 5, and 6 of Township 23, Range 18 less that portion within the Spring Hill Fire District.

All of Section 13, Township 22, Range 16.

All of Berkeley Manor, Phase I, as recorded in Plat Book 17, Page 75, Public Records of Hernando County, Florida.

Lot 1, Block C-3, Berkeley Manor, Plat Book 17, Page 18-22, Public Records of Hernando County, Florida.

Lots 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, and 14, Block 149 Berkeley Townsites, Plat Book 4, Page 10, Public Records of Hernando County.

All of section 10, Township 23 South, Range 17 East to the West of U.S. 19, and the East one half of Section 9, Township 23 South, Range 17 East.
