AN ORDINANCE TO BE KNOWN AS THE HERNANDO COUNTY CODE FOR
THE STORAGE AND HANDLING OF LIQUIFIED PETROLEUM GASES:
PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE STORAGE AND HANDLING OF
LIQUIFIED PETROLEUM GASES, 1989 EDITION (NFIPA 58-1989);
PROVIDING FOR THE SEVERANCE OF PARTS; PROVIDING FOR
VIOLATIONS, REMEDIES, AND PENALTIES; PROVIDING FOR AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA.

**SECTION 1. ADOPTION OF STORAGE AND HANDLING OF LIQUIFIED
PETROLEUM GASES, 1989 (NFIPA 58-1989) AS PROMULGATED BY
NATIONAL FIRE PROTECTION ASSOCIATION**

There is hereby adopted by the County of Hernando, Florida,
for the purpose of providing a jurisdiction with requirements for the
safe storage and handling of liquified petroleum gases, that certain
code known as the Storage and Handling of Liquified Petroleum Gases,
(NFIPA 58-1989), as recommended by the National Fire Protection
Association, a non-profit and non-political organization, with its
principal offices in Quincy, Massachusetts, being particularly the
1989 Edition. The same is hereby adopted and incorporated herein as
fully as if set forth in haec verba and from the date upon which this
ordinance shall take effect, the provisions thereof except as
otherwise noted herein shall be controlling in the safe storage and
handling of liquified petroleum gases within the unincorporated areas
of the County.

SECTION 2. ADMINISTRATION

For the administration of NFIPA 58-1989, refer to the
Standard Building Code, 1988 Edition, with the 1989 and 1990
Amendments, Chapter 1 - Administration.

SECTION 3. SEVERANCE OF PARTS

Should any section, paragraph, sentence, phrase, clause or
other part or provision of this ordinance be declared by any court to
be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance

as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part declared to be invalid.

SECTION 4. VIOLATIONS, REMEDIES, AND PENALTIES

Any entity violating any provision of this ordinance shall be subject to the penalties provided for herein. The Director or his authorized representative shall issue notice to all entities violating any provision of this ordinance and shall order that such violations cease. Should any entity fail to comply with such notice, or order, the Governing Body or its authorized official may institute appropriate action to bring such entity before a court of law for adjudication. Any entity violating any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined or imprisoned or both fined and imprisoned, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 125.69 of the Florida Statutes.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall become effective as provided by law.
