

ORDINANCE NO. 77-10

An Ordinance Amending Hernando County Ordinance No. 74-1 Pertaining to the Hernando County Parks and Recreation; Providing for the Parks and Recreation Director to be Employed or Terminated By the Board of County Commissioners; Providing for Additional Duties of the Board of Trustees; Providing for an Effective Date.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 4 of Hernando County Ordinance No. 74-1 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Such Board of Trustees shall have the authority to maintain, equip, and operate all public parks and recreational areas within the County, and such Board of Trustees may, for the purposes of carrying out the provisions of this Ordinance employ playleaders, playground directors, supervisors, recreational superintendents, or such other officers or employees as they deem proper; provided however that the employment and termination of the individual to hold the position of Hernando County Parks and Recreation Director shall be done by the Hernando County Board of County Commissioners.

Said Board of Trustees may erect such building or other improvements as it may deem necessary for the carrying out of the intent and purposes of this Ordinance, but any contracts therefore shall be governed by the general laws relating to contracts and expenditures of public money by public officials.

Said Board of Trustees shall have the power and authority to establish and conduct a system of supervised recreation and to contract or enter into cooperative arrangements for such purposes with other counties, with municipalities, with public school systems, or with agencies of the State of Florida or of the United States.

SECTION 2. Section 5 of Hernando County Ordinance No. 74-1 is hereby amended by adding thereto subparagraph (g) which shall read as follows:

(g) To work with the Hernando County Parks and Recreation Director to promote and develop parks and recreational facilities and activities within Hernando County.

SECTION 3. Sections 1, 2, 3, and 6 through 15 inclusive of Hernando County Ordinance No. 74-1 shall remain in full force and effect and unchanged by this amendment.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective as provided by law.
