

ORDINANCE NO. 82-12

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING HERNANDO COUNTY
ORDINANCE NO. 82-11

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE HERNANDO COUNTY BOARD OF
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Hernando County Ordinance No. 82-11, adopted
as an emergency ordinance by the Board of County Commissioners in
Regular Session on October 20, 1982, is hereby repealed.


SECTION 2. This ordinance shall become effective immediately
upon adoption.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is adopted as an emergency
ordinance as a result of the termination of the emergency situation which
previously existed due to the sever flooding of the Withlacoochee
River which had necessitated the prohibition of the use of boats,
other than for law enforcement or other governmental agencies for
evacuation purposes, on the Withlacoochee River.
