SECTION I AMENDMENT OF SECTION II. Section II of Ordinance 86-22, Hernando County, Florida is hereby amended so that such section shall be read as follows:

"SECTION II. CREATION OF UNIT

For the purpose of creating, establishing, maintaining and operating a fire hydrant system within the area described herein, there is hereby created a Municipal Service Taxing Unit to be known as the "BERKELEY MANOR PHASE I MUNICIPAL SERVICE TAXING UNIT", (FIRE HYDRANTS) which shall be all the property located in Hernando County, Florida, within the boundaries described in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference."

SECTION II INCLUSION IN THE CODE. It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners of Hernando County, Florida, and it is hereby provided, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of Hernando County, Florida. To this end, the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention, and that the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section", "article", or other appropriate designation.

SECTION III SEVERABILITY. It is declared to be the intent of the Board of County Commissioners that if any section,

subsection, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this Ordinance is for any reason held unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment from the office of the Secretary of State of Florida that this Ordinance has been filed with said office.
