BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION I AMENDMENT OF ORDINANCE NO 87-1. Ordinance 87-1, Hernando County, Florida, is hereby amended to add a section as follows:

"Exceptions. Any agrieved party may make application to the Board of County Commissioners for an exception to the prohibition of this Ordinance. Upon showing that a hardship exists and after a finding that such a hardship does exist, the Board of County Commissioners, in its sole and absolute discretion, may approve the issuance of a building permit. No such permit shall be authorized except to provide for the replacement of existing or pre-existing buildings, mobile homes, structures or devices. Any such permits so issued shall be issued only after the applicant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Hernando County or any agency thereof. For any and all damages which may either occur to or as a result of the building, mobile home, structure or device so replaced."

SECTION II INCLUSION IN THE CODE. It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners of Hernando County, Florida, and it is hereby provided, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of Hernando County, Florida. To this end, the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention, and that the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section", "article", or other appropriate designation.

SECTION III SEVERABILITY. It is declared to be the intent of the Board of County Commissioners that if any section, subsection, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this Ordinance is for any reason held unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance, adopted pursuant to the Emergency Enactment Procedure of §125.66 (3), Florida Statutes, shall become effective when a copy has been accepted by the United States Postal Service for special delivery by registered mail to the Department of State.
