AN ORDINANCE OF HERNANDO COUNTY PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF ORDINANCE NO. 87-13 BE AMENDED BY ADDING A SECTION TO BE NUMBERED SECTION 8; PROVIDING THAT NON-MOTORIZED TRAFFIC BE ALLOWED ON CERTAIN PORTIONS OF THE WITHLACOOCHEE RIVER; PROVIDING PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION I AMENDMENT OF ORDINANCE NO 87-13. Ordinance 87-13, Hernando County, Florida, is hereby amended to add a section to be numbered Section 8, to read as follows:

"SECTION 8. Section 3 of this Ordinance shall not apply to non-motorized boats, boatcraft or watercraft operated on that portion of the Withlacoochee River between the northernmost point of Hog Island and the southernmost point of Silver Lake."

SECTION II SEVERABILITY. It is declared to be the intent of the Board of County Commissioners that if any section, subsection, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this Ordinance is for any reason held unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION III EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance, adopted pursuant to the Emergency Enactment Procedure of §125.66 (3), Florida Statutes, shall become effective when a copy has been accepted by the United States Postal Service for special delivery by registered mail to the Department of State.
