

ORDINANCE NO. 87-15

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING HERNANDO
COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 87-13 & NO. 87-14

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE HERNANDO COUNTY BOARD OF
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Hernando County Ordinance No. 87-13 and 87-
14 is hereby rescinded.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall become effective upon
official announcement by the National Weather Service that the
Withlacoochee River has dropped below flood stage throughout
Hernando County.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is adopted as an emergency
ordinance as a result of the termination of the emergency
situation which previously existed due to the severe flooding of
the Withlacoochee River which had necessitated the prohibition of
the use of boats, other than for law enforcement or other
governmental agencies for evacuation purposes, on the
Withlacoochee River.
