

ORDINANCE NO. 86-4

AN ORDINANCE OF HERNANDO COUNTY PROVIDING THAT ORDINANCE NO. 85-24 OF HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA, BE AMENDED BY REVISING SECTIONS V AND VII OF SAID ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR THE FEE TO BE EFFECTIVE ON NOVEMBER 1, 1985, OR AS SOON THEREAFTER AS PRACTICAL; PROVIDING FOR A FEE OF FIFTY (.50¢) CENTS PER MONTH PER LINE FOR EACH LOCAL EXCHANGE SUBSCRIBER ACCOUNT; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION I AMENDMENT. That Section V of Ordinance No. 85-24 be amended so that such Section shall read as follows:

"SECTION V. The fees imposed hereunder shall be effective November 1, 1985, or as soon thereafter as may be practical for the affected telephone companies to include such fees in the telephone companys' monthly billing cycle but in no event later than the first billing cycle in 1986. The fees shall continue thereafter for a period of eighteen (18) months from the date first imposed."

SECTION II AMENDMENT. That Section VII of Ordinance No. 85-24 be amended so that such Section shall read as follows:

"SECTION VII. The telephone companies providing "911" service to Hernando County shall include a monthly charge of fifty (.50¢) cents per line up to a maximum of twenty-five (25) lines per subscriber account in the telephone companies regular billing for telephone service."

SECTION III INCLUSION IN THE CODE. It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners of Hernando County, Florida, and it is hereby provided, that the provisions of Ordinance No.

85-24, as amended by this Ordinance, shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of Hernando County, Florida. To this end, the sections of Ordinance No. 85-24, as amended by this Ordinance, may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention, and that the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section", "article", or other appropriate designation.

SECTION IV EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment from the office of the Secretary of State of Florida that this Ordinance has been filed with said office.
