

ORDINANCE NO. 75-12

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING HERNANDO COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 75-8 BY PROVIDING FOR THE HERNANDO COUNTY SANITARIAN TO BE THE ENFORCING OFFICIAL INSTEAD OF THE HERNANDO COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT; MAKING FINDINGS OF FACT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA:


SECTION 1. Enforcing Official: Hernando County Ordinance No. 75-8 is hereby amended by substituting "Hernando County Sanitarian" for "Hernando County Health Department" wherever within said Ordinance the term "Hernando County Health Department" shall appear.

SECTION 2. Findings: The Hernando County Board of County Commissioners hereby determines and finds that an emergency exists inasmuch as there are a number of violations of Hernando County Ordinance No. 75-8 and in order to expeditiously enforce said Ordinance, the amendments to said Ordinance must come into effect.

SECTION 3. Effective Date: This Ordinance shall become effective when a copy of it has been accepted by the Postal authorities of the government of the United States for special delivery by registered mail to the Department of State of the State of Florida.


ADOPTED as an emergency ordinance by a unanimous vote of all five (5) members of the Hernando County Board of County Commissioners, in Regular Session, on the 15th day of July, 1975.
