

ORDINANCE NO. 76-6

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING HERNANDO COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 76-4, REQUIRING IDENTIFICATION ON COMMERCIAL VEHICLES, BY REQUIRING CERTAIN SPECIFIED LETTERING UPON SPECIFIED VEHICLES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Hernando County Ordinance No. 76-4 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"The vehicle required to be marked, pursuant to Section 1, shall contain the following identification markings: (a) Contractor's name; (b) Contractor's business location; and (c) Contractor's certificate of competency number.

"The foregoing markings shall be on both the right and left sides of the vehicle and shall be in contrasting colors to the colors of the vehicle. The height of letters shall not be less than 1 1/2 inches in height."

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall become effective as provided by law.
