

ORDINANCE NO. 77-3

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING HERNANDO COUNTY
ORDINANCE NO. 76-12 CREATING THE ISTA-
CHATTA-NOBLETON RECREATION AND COMMUNITY
HALL DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR A SEVEN
MEMBER BOARD OF DISTRICT SUPERVISORS;
PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE HERNANDO COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Hernando County Ordinance
No. 76-12 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. The Istachatta-Nobleton Recreation Dis-
trict shall be governed by a Board of District Supervisors
(hereinafter called the "Board") which shall consist of seven
members who shall be qualified electors within the District,
and who shall serve for two-year terms. Appointments to the
Board shall be made by the Hernando County Board of County
Commissioners, and the members' terms shall run from January
to December 31.

Should there at any time be a vacancy on the Board
of the District, the Hernando County Board of County Commis-
sioners shall appoint a member to fill the balance of the term
of office of such member. The Hernando County Board of County
Commissioners shall have the power to remove a member for non-
feasance, misfeasance, or malfeasance, and change of residence
from within the District. Members shall post bond as required
and set by the Hernando County Board of County Commissioners."

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall become effective as
provided by law.
